# CITUS HILL HIGH SCHOOL

As your final year comes to a close, this newsletter will serve as a helpful guide to keep on hand for senior information from now through the end of the school year. Although many senior activities are voluntary, we hope that all eligible seniors will participate in as many of the events as possible. All of these activities will be a memorable end to your high school career. With your energetic and positive participation, your senior year will come to an enjoyable conclusion.

The purpose of this newsletter is not only to provide you with necessary information, but also to remind seniors and their parents that school and district rules and regulations apply through the very last minute of all senior activities. Serious consequences, including suspension and/or expulsion from school, the denial of participation from any of these senior activities, or withholding of your diploma may occur if rules of conduct are violated.

Although all of the information in this document is important, we want to highlight the key expectations.

**Senior Behavior Contract:** Each graduating senior must have a Senior Behavior Contract on file by August 31, 2014, in order to participate in any and all senior activities.

**Disciplinary Consequences.** No senior will be allowed to participate in any senior activity if they have any pending disciplinary consequence on their record. **The school district's alcohol/drug policy will be strictly enforced.** Any student who is found to have consumed or to be in possession of drugs/alcohol will be suspended from school for five days (recommended for expulsion if the second offense). Law Enforcement will be notified.

**Any vandalism of the campus** - from pranks to serious destruction of property - will be treated swiftly and severely. Pranks and vandalism will keep students from participating in the Graduation Ceremony and could impact remaining Senior activities for the entire class. Don't lose out on this important moment because of a bad decision or involvement in such behavior!

**Debts.** All graduating seniors must clear their debts to both Citrus Hill High School/Val Verde Unified School District and any other schools which have placed a debt against the student. No senior will be allowed to participate in any senior activity as long as there is a debt against them.

**Graduation Ceremony will be held at Citrus Hill in the Football Stadium May 28<sup>th</sup> at 6:30. Tickets will be required to attend the Graduation Ceremony.** Each Senior will be given 4 tickets free of charge. Seniors in need of more tickets will be able to purchase an additional 4 tickets at \$5 each until April 30, 2015; any unsold tickets will be sold starting May 1st. More information to follow.

**Senior Eligibility:** In order to participate in Senior activities during graduation week Seniors must meet all graduation requirements, including, but not limited to: 220 credits, required classes, free and clear of all school/district debts, and not on the No Activity List. Seniors who do not meet these requirements may not participate in Senior Celebration Meal, Graduation Practice, Graduation and Grad Nite.

**Graduation Caps and Gowns and Senior Items:** The official supplier of Citrus Hill High School Senior products is Herff-Jones represented by Brandi Potenga. Seniors will not be allowed to wear graduation gowns or caps that have been altered or decorated in any way. Only approved medals, awards, stoles and cords may be worn. No flower leis or other similar items may be worn.

Senior portraits will be taken at the Lifetouch/Prestige Studio in the Ralph's Shopping Center in Mission Grove 301 East Alessandro St. Ste 3A, Riverside 92508. **Appointments are available June 30-July 2.** Pictures must be submitted by October 15, 2014 to be included in the yearbook.

**Senior "Ditch Days":** Citrus Hill High School does not promote, encourage or support any Senior Ditch Day. Seniors are expected to be at school every day until Graduation. Seniors who participate in "Senior Ditch Days" are subject to appropriate discipline and may forfeit all Senior activities, including walking at Graduation.
