

Citrus Hill High School Senior Contract

Seniors are to be role models for our younger students and as such must be held to a standard of behavior that is in accordance with this expectation. As you find yourself nearing the end of your high school experience there is always the temptations to participate in some type of activity that does not adhere to the school rules or California Education Code under 48900. The following violations will be cause for disallowing a student to participate in Senior activities and may place the Senior's "walking" at graduation in jeopardy:

- Fighting, the use of force upon the person of another, or threats of violence against another.
- Possession of objects considered to be a weapon. i.e.: knife, laser pointer, gun, pepper spray, a device capable of shooting and object, brass knuckles, explosive device (fire cracker etc.), lighter, or any other object that can be used as a weapon.
- Possession of or under the influence of, or selling or providing drugs or alcohol.
- Vandalism of any kind to school property or the property of another.
- Profanity.
- Theft.
- Receiving stolen property.
- Sexual harassment.
- Creating a disturbance at school or school activity.

Finally, attendance is mandatory; unacceptable tardiness, unexcused absences, including participation in "Senior ditch days," may be cause for exclusion from Senior activities. Those Seniors on the No Activities List must be removed from the list prior to attending Senior activities, including Prom.

As we near the end of the school year each of us should reflect upon our early beginnings at Citrus Hill High School and recognize what great strides each Senior has made in becoming a mature and responsible young man or young women and hold true to the values that have been instilled in each of us at Citrus Hill High School.
